With grades 2-5 in the *PS3 'til 6* after-school program, I focused on scene study, improvisation, vocal technique, theatre history, character building, and team work. Final project is a 20 minute version of a musical with scenes and songs. From September 2020 to July 2021, our virtual class wrote and performed 3 original plays with music and an original sketch variety show.

Choral Director/Private Voice at Greenwich House School of Music; NY, NY – Mar. 2017- Dec. 2018

Directed outreach after-school choruses at PS41 and PS89 that focused on group sound, repertoire expansion, and music theory. I wrote the curriculum for and taught a pilot collaborative program with PS3 for a songwriting chorus. This program was funded for expansion and continues today with other educators. Additionally, taught private voice students of all ages at Greenwich House where the mission is to not only aid in creating stellar musicians, but to encourage a joy for music that continues throughout life.

Working mainly with 6th-8th graders, I taught Songwriting at The Professional Performing Arts School (PPAS), Lower Manhattan Community School (LMC), and Choir at LAB Middle School.
